

#### Annual rainfall 1000-2000 mm annum <sup>-1</sup>




# Water in Ireland.....

 Lakes and rivers provide many services for the human population.


- But are vulnerable to a wide range of stressors.





**Boil Water Notice - Leitrim**

There is currently a boil water notice in place for the Churchfield Water Supply Scheme.

Sampling is currently being carried out by Leitrim Co. Council on behalf of Irish Water.

On the advice of the Health Service Executive a boil water notice has been issued in respect of this scheme. Accordingly, in the interest of public health, it is recommended that all users of the water scheme boil water before use.

Water must be boiled for:

- Drinking
- Drinks made with water
- Preparation of salads and similar food which are not cooked prior to eating
- Brushing of teeth
- Making of ice
